<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Welcome, introductions • CELEBRATION • AAPP around for 12 years, created by those involved in community assessment for a children's hospital – wanted a safe place for institutions (major hospitals, governments with health powers) to plan, work for pediatric resources for all of Alaska's kids – step back from completion and suspicion, maintain longtime relationships; • Success not possible without AAPP foundation of trust, working relationships (financial hassles as getting money on the ground takes LONG TIME) could call upon partners to find expertise; • Ambitious goals but grounded in real world challenges with real world solutions proposed and practical lessons learned; • Brought together emergency management (facilities personnel) and medical providers as never before: a model for adult providers –and for the nation; • Hired a manager, coordinator for those skills with some pediatric medical knowledge and longtime Alaska living as expertise in areas of curriculum 	<p>Mary, Sally</p>

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<p>creation, exercise administration, systems development, grant management was enthusiastically engaged from all the partners involved;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Serious as we met every other week creating a culture of support, finding solutions, engaging new folks along the way; • Because AAPP “coordinated” MEP-P, relationships will continue with leadership from State; • Encourage all to seek appointment with their CEO, Commissioner, top leadership to review this success AND point how your institution will build on this success. • On plenary session agenda for Annual Health Summit for one speaker but will find way to include another to continue demonstrating partnership; • Stories shared about practical lessons learned along with way, including what happens when a team member is caught in traffic and doesn’t make a flight; • Had real world test during project with RSV outbreak I Bethel this past spring; • Two exercises, the day one with all the Anchorage hospitals and the table top one that included sending a team to Barrow, taught us much as well as began relationships with EOCs, etc.; • Still need to complete final reports, some equipment distribution; • Having an impartial coordinator was key to success; • Many in awe of our success in a year since it was just over a year ago that Sally met with Dr. Mandsager to talk about how to get in front of the annual RSV. With the announcement of the federal competitive grant, brought in AAPP and submitted what was one of 11 chosen, the only one responsive about a special population (kids); • Planning a two-day training for providers following Annual Health Summit with Cleveland State trainers. <p>Jay Butler, MD, Chief Medical Officer for Alaska, added his thanks for all our work and his commitment to use learning in many ways.</p> <p>Dr. Wallington asked that comments about the draft ethics papers be sent to her by the end of August.</p> <p>All are reminded to review final report and let Mary know if you are willing to continue on specific team and/or the steering committee.
